Also, you know, appearing in a revival (thanks to BTW, Netflix). 1 out of 40 then: Alexis Bledel Alexis Bledel landed her breakout role as Rory Gilmore when she was just 19 years old. While working on the series, Alexis began her career in film, starring in the films Eternal Turner and Sisterhood of Traveling Pants. 2 out of 40 now: Alexis Bledel With Gilmore Girls, Alexis' career continues to flourish. The actress starred in Mad Men in 2012, where she met her now-husband Vincent Cartheizer. She also won an Emmy for her role in the tale of the handmaid Hulu. She recently announced plans for Sisterhood Travel Pants 3. 3 out of 40 THEN: Lauren Graham In 1996, Lauren Graham snagged her first television role in a guest spot on 3rd Rock from the Sun, but she didn't hit her stride as an actress until she played a fast-talking, coffee crazy single mother, Lorelai Gilmore. 4 out of 40 now: Lauren Graham Lauren enjoyed several roles in films such as Evan Almighty and because I said so after farewell to the stars of Hollow. She made her triumphant return to television in 2010 as Sarah Braverman on NBC's Parents. The show ran for six seasons, and she met her partner, Peter Kraus, on stage. He played her TV brother! 5 out of 40 THEN: Kelly Bishop Kelly Bishop has been working in television and film since the late 1950s. Her first role was on a soap opera as the world turns around and she later appeared in Dirty Dancing. In 2000, the actress played the role of Emily Gilmore, the rich and cold matriarch of the Gilmore family. I've always enjoyed playing what I call nasty, rich women. Because I can't stand them, she told the panel in 2016. So I try to make them as horrible as possible. 6 out of 40 NOW: The Kelly Bishop actress hasn't appeared in many roles since the revival of A Year In The Life in 2016, but she thoroughly enjoyed the journey that the writers sent her during the reunion. I've been to From what they wrote, I really was. Kelly told The Hollywood Reporter. It was just wonderful for me because it really goes to a few different places. 7 out of 40 40 Edward Herrmann Edward Herrmann was one of the most recognizable names when he starred as Richard Gilmour, Rory's dashing and intellectual grandfather. From overboard to Annie, he was an impeccably trained actor who was instantly recognizable for his high and strong stature. 8 out of 40 2014: Edward Herrmann Sadly, Edward died in New York in 2014 at the age of 71, after battling brain cancer. The actor continued to work, appearing in Good Wife, The Wolf of Wall Street and Black Box at the end of his life. The cast shared their grief over his loss, and his death was recorded in a reunion series. 9 out of 40 THEN: Scott Patterson's Scott Patterson has small parts on hit shows like Seinfeld and Will and Grace before he was cast as the grumpy diner owner, Luke Danes, on the Warner Brothers show. 10 out of 40 NOW: Scott Patterson In addition to appearing on the Netflix revival a few years ago, Scott starred in the horror films Saw IV and Saw V. The actor is also a musician on the side. 11 out of 40 THEN: Melissa McCarthy's Melissa McCarthy began her career in the 90s, working as a stand-up comedian, but her first major role on television as a quirky chef and loyal best friend of Lorelai, Sookie St. James, on Gilmore Girls. 12 out of 40 now: Melissa McCarthy After starring in her Emmy-winning TV show, Mike and Molly, the actress stole the show in the movie Bridesmaids and became one of the biggest names in comedy. The actress recently moved her roles to more serious films such as the Oscar-nominated Can You Ever Forgive Me? She will also star as Ursula in the upcoming live-action version of The Little Mermaid. 13 out of 40 THEN: David Sutcliffe Canadian actor had smaller roles before joining Gilmore Girls at the end of season 1 as Rory's absentee father, Christopher Hayden. David became a recurring character throughout the series and the actor enjoyed success on the side with roles in films like Under the Tuscan Sun. 14 out of 40 NOW: David Sutcliffe After the show wrapped in 2007, David went to work on private practice, as well as a star in his own crime series, Cracked. Most recently, he appeared on the Amazon Prime series Romanoffs. 15 out of 40 THEN: The Keiko Agena actress was 27 years old when she was cast to play Rory's best friend and confidant, 15-year-old Lane Kim. She remained a major member of the cast throughout the seven seasons. Prior to the Gilmore Girls, Keiko had minor roles on shows like Felicity and Beverly Hills, 90210. 16 out of 40 now: Keiko Iyena After leaving her role as Lane Kim behind, Keiko has landed minor roles on television and in movies for years. But since the Gilmore Girls mini-series revival, Keiko has been in some of the biggest new shows, including 13 Reasons Why, Better Call Saul, and Dirty John. 17 out of 40 THEN: Jared Padalecki's Jared Padalecki's Jared Padalecki was just starting out as an actor when he signed on to play Dean, Rory's first boyfriend. The actor had a recurring role until 2005, when something happens to most first likes likes Rory and Dean broke up. Meanwhile, Jared began starring in films such as Cheaper by a Dozen and The New York Minute. 18 out of 40 NOW: Jared Padalecki After Jared left the show in 2005, he appeared in several horror films (House of Wax and Friday the 13th) and landed the lead role in the hit TV show Supernatural, which is set to end after its current 15th season. 19 out of 40 THEN: Lisa Well After getting small parts in television shows like The West Wing and Law: A Special Group of Victims, Lisa's first major role was as Paris Gellar-Rory overachieving a classmate at her competitive private school. Although they became Rory's enemies, they eventually became friends, and Lisa's role became a staple of the storylines. 20 out of 40 now: Lisa Vale's life after Gilmore Girls was very good for Lisa. After several guest spots on the show as a private practice, Lisa has been recurring a role in the first season of Scandal and is currently acting on How to Get Away with Murder. 21 out of 40 THEN: Chad Michael Murray Every millennial remembers young Chad Michael Murray, who had a small but mighty role as high school heartthrob Tristan in Season 1. Chad made his debut on the show just as his star is rising in Hollywood. 22 out of 40 now: Chad Michael Murray Soon after, Chad exploded. He landed the lead role in the hit show One Tree Hill, as well as parts of Freaky Friday and the Cinderella story -- opposite Lindsay Lohan and Hilary Duff, respectfully. Lately, he's been acting on another hit teen drama: Riverdale. 23 out of 40 THEN: Milo Ventimiglia Milo Ventimiglia rose through the ranks as a television actor in the mid-nineties, appearing in Sabrina the Teenage Witch and Saved the Bell. In season 2 of Gilmore Girls, he joined the cast as Jess Mariano, a love interest for Rory and Luke's nephew. 24 out of 40 now: Milo Ventimiglia Milo followed Gilmore Girls with another hit show, Heroes. But his biggest part to date is playing the matriarch of the Pearson family on NBC's HIT show This Is Us. He also starred in the recently released film The Art of Racing in the Rain. 25 out of 40 THEN: Liz Torres is no stranger to television when she was cast as Miss Patty in 2000. The actress has been appearing on the sitcom since 1965 and has been best known for her role in The John Larroque show in the 90s. 26 out of 40 now: Liz Torres actress has had a series of guest parts on the show ever since, including Scandal. It was recently announced that she will appear in the upcoming film Chick Flick. 27 out of 40 THEN: Sean Gunn Sean Gunn had several small roles on television and in movies before he became known as the Odd Towns, Kirk Gleeson, on The Gilmore Girls. 28 out of 40 now: Shaun Gunn Sean made a juuust penalty with Gilmore Girls. The actor, whose brother is directed by James Gunn, plays Craglin in the guardians of the Galaxy and The Avengers. 29 out of 40 THEN: Sally Struthers of America first met Sally Struthers for her role in All In The Family, playing Bunker. After that, she went to the theater. The actress bopped around appearing on various shows until she filled the role of Lorelai and Rory's big-hearted neighbor, Babette, on Gilmore Girls. 30 of 40 NOW: The Sally Struthers Actress continues to appear in theater and television and reprised her role as Babette in Netflix's mini-series Revival.
